- I thought we could **call in** Lisa on our way home.

- The landlord have **called in** the police to investigate the burglary.

21. **call out** bağırarak, seslenmek = shout

- He said he tried to **call out** through the window, but I didn't hear anything.

devreye sokmak, göreve çağırmak = call in, summon into service

- The government officials were **called out** to deal with the matter.

22. **care for** bakmak, ilgilenmek = look after

- Mike doesn't **care for** his pets well.
- The patient is well **cared for** in the hospital.

23. **carry on (with)** devam etmek = continue doing

- Although they were tired, they **carried on** walking.
- I would like to **carry on with** my education here as this is the best school I can get into.
