Thinking and feeling are rival instruments of decision. Both are reasonable and internally consistent but each works by its own standards. Thinking evaluates from the viewpoint "true-false" and feeling from "agreeable-disagreeable". The important point to recognize is that each kind of judgment has its appropriate field. To use feeling where thinking is called for might be a mistake as much as to use thinking where feeling is required.
